

Initial Incident Commander/Qualified Individual Activities



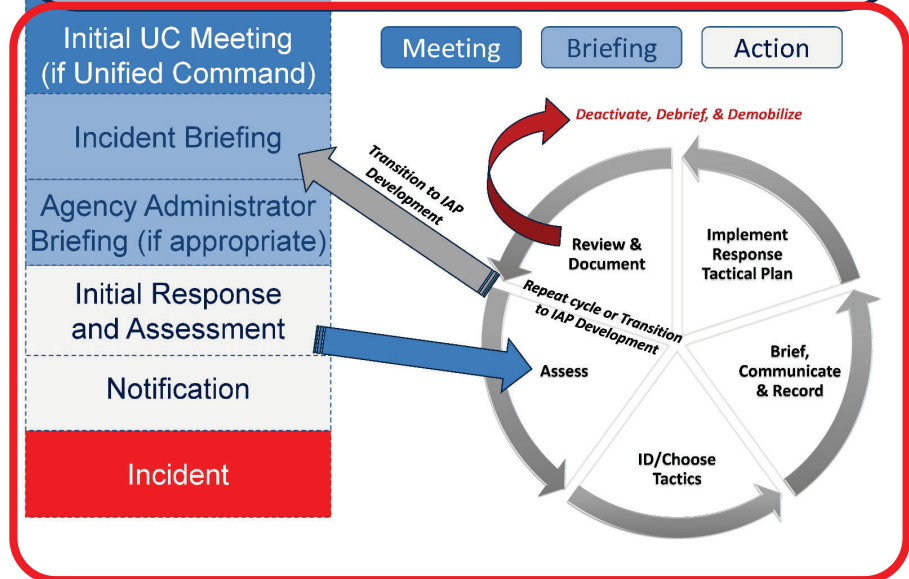
- Initial UC Meeting (if Unified Command)**
- Finalize UC structure
 - Determine overall response organization
 - Identify and select support facilities
 - Clarify UC roles and responsibilities
 - Determine Operational period
 - Select OSC & Deputy OSC

- Incident Briefing**
- Determine ICS-201 briefing timeframe & receive briefing
 - Clarify/request additional information
 - Determine incident complexity
 - Provide interim direction
 - Initiate change of command
 - Determine UC players
 - Ensure interagency notifications
 - Brief superiors

- Initial Response and Assessment**
- Ensure that an appropriate initial response is deployed
 - Activate and engage in contracting with OSRO
 - Obligate funds required to carry out response activities
 - Provide direction as needed
 - Monitor initial response operations
 - Act as a liaison with the pre-designated FOSC

- Notification**
- QI must be available on a 24-hour basis
 - QI must be able to arrive at the facility within a reasonable time

- Incident**
- Ensure QI is designated in writing, to include specifying QI's full authorities
 - Be familiar with implementation of FRP
 - Be trained in responsibilities of the QI under the response plan



Initial Incident Commanders/Qualified Individuals will likely operate in the stem of the Operational Planning Cycle (or "P").
